About This Game

You are about to uncover four twisted tales of misadventure surrounding people connected, in some way, by the late Dr. Cyrus Stansfield's cloning machine. Within these stories you must face the ethical dilemmas and possible fortune while guiding each character to their own end.

The story takes place in the city of Starkham; the same location as One Way To Die and The Dope Game, and features recognizable places and characters spanning both games. Owners of previous games will get alternate story chunks unlocked as well.

In the proper fashion of text adventures, the player starts a story and navigates by making decisions at certain times to move

forward. Each decision has a variety of outcomes and consequences, many of which have randomized elements to them. Before the start of each story, the player is given the opportunity to change various elements about the story, similar to Mad Libs. These changes will move forward with each story as the player progresses.



The game comes with four stories which are released in episodic fashion:

Story One

The Addict follows the nephew of Dr. Stansfield, Marsch, after he gets out of rehab and inherits his uncle's mansion and lab. Will he fall back to old habits and ruin this opportunity or will he take advantage of it and finally improve his life while continuing the family legacy?

Story Two

The Doctor reveals exactly what happened to Dr. Stansfield leading to his nephew taking over. How did he die? Did he even actually die at all?

Story Three

The Neighbor follows a little girl, Madelyn, who stumbles into the lab after it has been condemned following the nephew's untimely mistakes. She also falls victim to the cloning machine and must not only clear her good name but stop her clone from doing further damage.

Story Four

The Clone is about Aloysius, one of the clones who survives Marsch's failed experiment, who tries to make sense of everything that happened since then as well as unravel the mystery of Dr. Stansfield's death.

The game launched with story one, The Addict, with the additional stories to follow as episodic updates.



The game also keeps track of various statistics, both personal and global, such as decisions made, random events encountered, and wins/losses over games played. Progress on each story's branches is also kept so the player can use it to experience all the different outcomes for each one, if they choose.

There are also a total of twenty-five achievements broken up among the stories, five each, as well as five global ones.

This is a really neat strategy game. It's unique and well-made and I had to read negative reviews to even remember anything negative. It looks like the main complaints (apart from people who thought it was a sim) are that it's too random and too difficult, and I definitely sympathize with both of those things. It's got all the randomness that comes with a deck-building game, but it also has a lot of things that mitigate the randomness - character powers, specific actions on cards, and most cards are a building that have to be placed strategically on the grid. I do think the card shop could be less random but overall it didn't bother me too much, and I'm not someone who enjoys randomness.. 9 hours in and just finished the last available boss, now for epic mode and getting ready for the lich. great game overall. For a prototype made by 2 people, it was really good. Awesome that they kept working and released 3 games in the "Doorways" series.. Co-op suport is only local splitscreen, misleading tags made me buy this game.. My first review ever but only to say its the worst game ever.

I loved Machine World on the iPad. Machine World 2 even tough it's in early access, is just not really fun to play. There's a LOT to improve. I would consider it an alpha version. The controls are SUPER QUIRKY at the moment. I never had so much trouble entering a vehicle as with this game! It's really sad, that this game doesn't follow the great attributes and the SIMPLICITY of Machine World 1... I'll check out the game again in a year or so, right now it's just not worth it.. I just want to select the wrong anwers in this game which is contrary to when I played the first one.. Dynasty Feud is the best platform arena fighting game steam has to offer, and one of the best local multiplayer games as well.

While games like Towerfall and Samurai Gunn rekindled interest in this style of game, years later other developers have managed to surpass these games. Kaia Studios have done just that with Dynasty Feud.

It is therefor a shame that some of the newer entries to the genre have not been able to gain as much traction as the earlier releases. Dynasty Feud deserves a similar following.

The twist offered by Dynasty Feud is that instead of picking a character, you pick a team. Each team is balanced, has their own playstyle, and has stronger and weaker characters.

Each game starts with a spawn countdown, in which you can select the character on your team that you wish to spawn, and after death you can also select your new character (as well as cast a team-unique taunt before spawning).

This gives some extra tactical depth as well, as you can select a character well suited to dealing with a particularly difficult enemy.

Combat is relatively simple, with only two attacks per character - however each character is different so in any one match you get to use a range of different skills.

The fact that you have a suit of characters means that the game modes are centred around survival rather than kills. However Dynasty Feud deals with this by issuing stars when a character scores a kill or dies. At five stars you can cast your team's super attack - which is a very effective tool.

With 8 teams and 40 characters, the game has a lot of playability. If you like this style of game, Dynasty Feud is a must have.

A few of these "Hidden Object" game companies have a much better screen layout so it was something of an adjustment, but the crisp aesthetic and unique setting made up for it. So, I've heard a lot of things about the 3D Worms games, and almost none of them were positive. But this game looked fine, so I gave it a shot on my own terms. Yes, it's different, and it can be a bit buggy (though frankly Worms games in general get that sometimes; even good ol' Armageddon's had its share), and the camera is a bit of a pain, but this game is still really fun in its own right. Of course, I've also been using a controller and that might make a difference. I dunno.

To name a few things I like, well for one, your Worms teams can be personalized right down to having a custom-made weapon. I always enjoyed that sort of thing. The random map generator works well to keep deathmatches consistent but not monotonous, and the different types of scenery keep things interesting too, given that buildings and such provide cover in 3D. Game styles can be edited pretty well too, so creative souls can further liven things up and provide variety.

The single-player content is also fun to play through, and AI opponents have a few more tricks than just shooting Bazookas and Grenades at you. Though they're still dummies who literally can't climb to save their lives. Of course, the main thing you'd want is the chance to blow up your friends, and fortunately this game can provide local multiplayer on a single machine in proper Worms fashion.

Overall, a nice find. Can't be the judge about other 3D Worms titles, but I do recommend this one.. Beautiful construction but underwhelming gameplay. The voice acting is without peer, the scripting and the staging (literally, you're on a stage) is awesome, and the dancing and visuals are beautiful. But as a game, it felt very... empty. Like my participation was only incidental to the story. Pretty much the only thing you can do is capture 4 red petals. The capture of these petals progress the storyline.

As a side note, this production is height-discriminatory. My 6 year old daughter wanted to play, but really couldn't reach the petals during interactive stages. Excellent game!
